

Anticipating a Post-Disaster Supply Chain Disruption

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Scenario - Background

- You currently work for a major retailer in the United States with > 4,000 US stores
- Recent data shows: >40% of the US population regularly buys from your stores
- Due to your complex network of stores, and the need to maximize distribution and satisfy demand, your organization uses distribution centers
- With this network, the company reduces costs by purchasing large amounts of goods and distribute smaller quantities as required by demand in stores
- Using Walmart in Florida within this scenario

Scenario – Problem Statement

- Your organization receives information that a potential hurricane will impact Dade, Broward, and Palm Beach counties.
- Your organization wants to ship inventory for high-demand items (water, milk, diapers, batteries, flashlights, and first aid supplies) to these counties.
- Each Florida store (even those outside the designated counties) will keep a high level of stock and not share their inventory with the potentially affected counties.
- The hurricane trajectory model shows the state of Georgia may be impacted so you cannot use distribution centers in Georgia.

Identifying Stores at Risk – Building the Database

Search online for Walmart Stores for each Florida county. Start with Dade.

Add each store to an Excel spreadsheet, including the address and type of store. Then do the same for the other 2 counties.

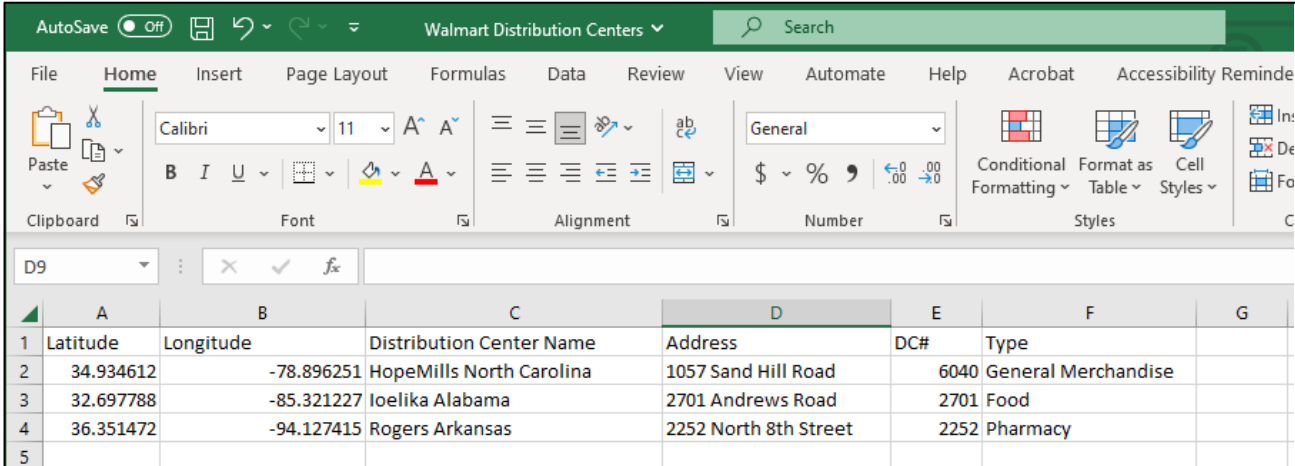

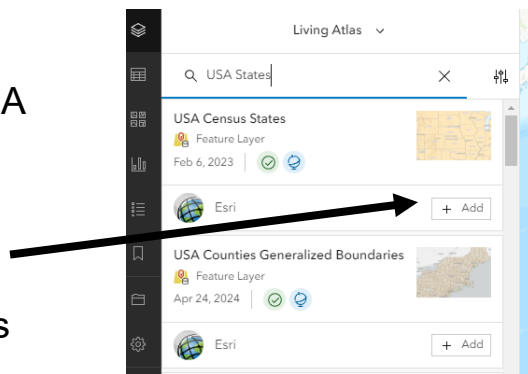

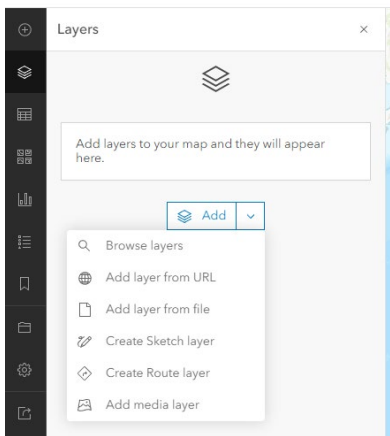

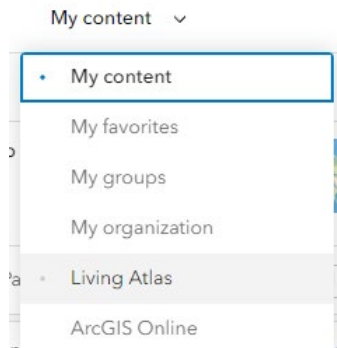


Setting up a Map – adding US state outlines

1. Click on the down arrow next to **Add**, choose Browse layers

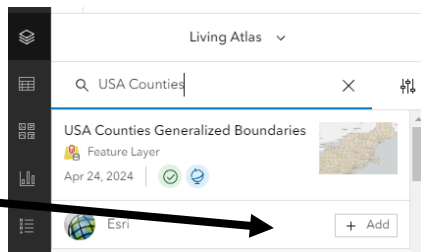


2. Click on the down arrow next to My content and choose Living Atlas

4. Click on **Add** next to USA Counties Generalized Boundaries

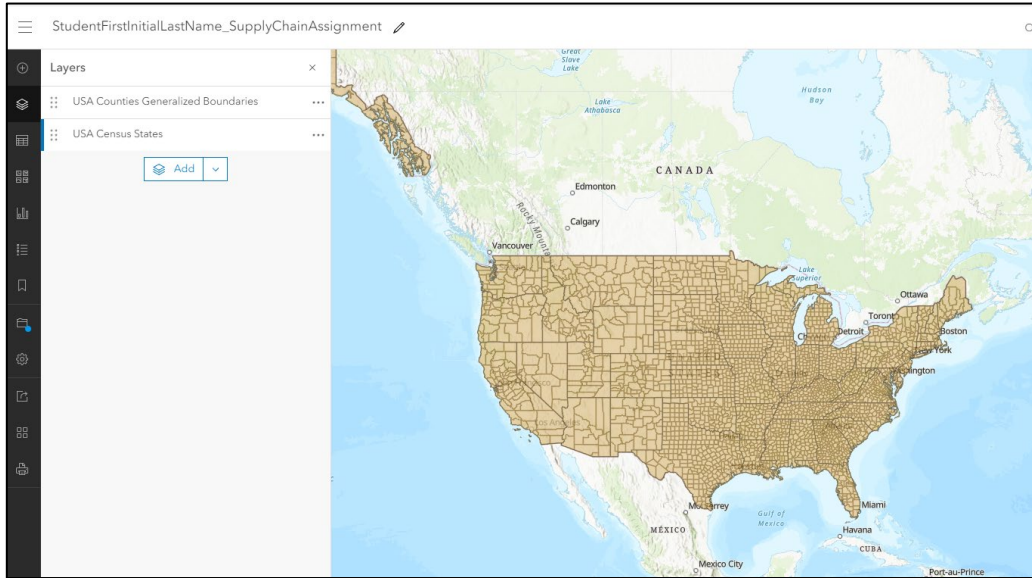


Setting up a Map – adding US county outlines

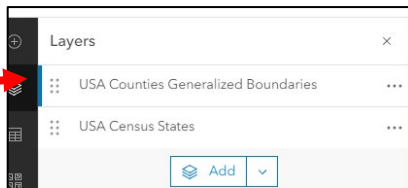


The state outlines are in the map but hidden by the counties. In the next two slides, you will learn how to display the states boundaries and only the Florida counties

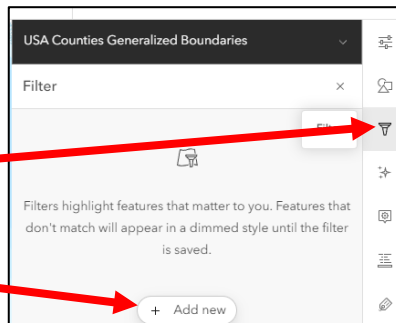
Setting up a Map – State and Counties Results



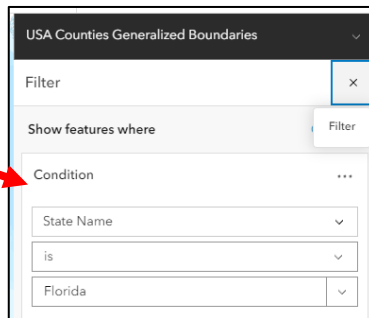
1. Click on the USA Counties layer, so it shows blue on the left



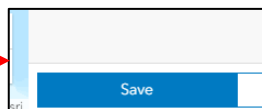
2. On the right side of the screen click on Filter



3. Click on Add new



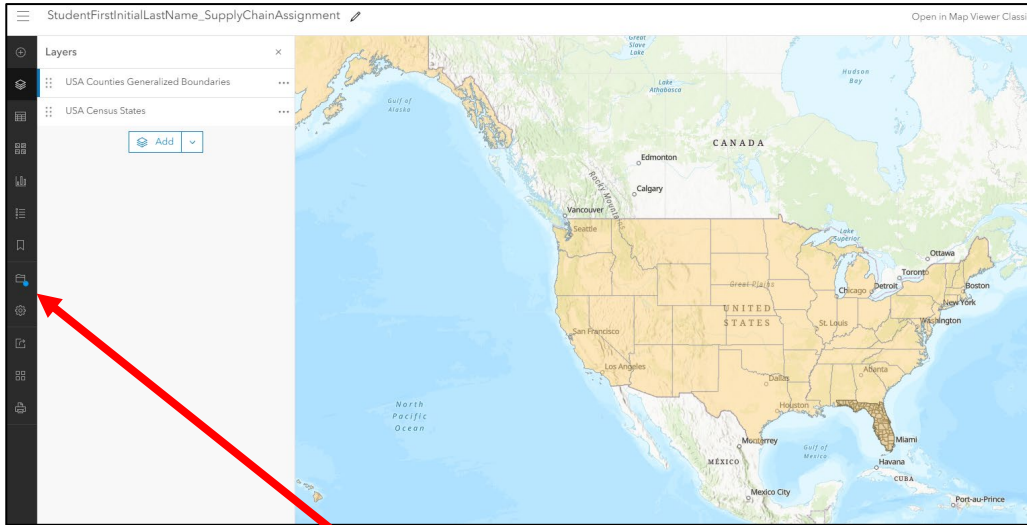
4. Enter the information as shown

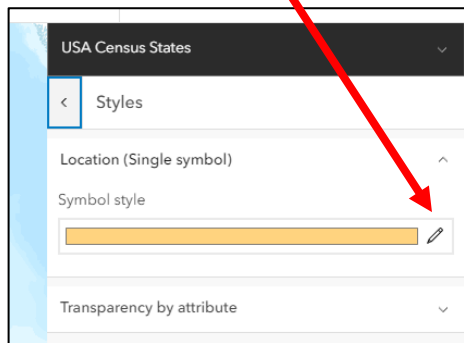

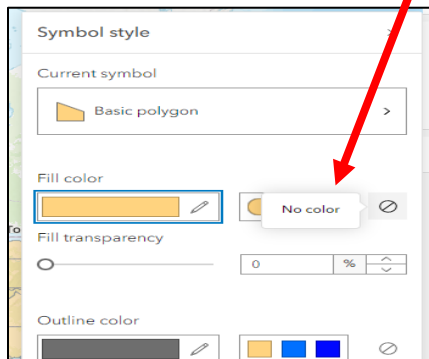

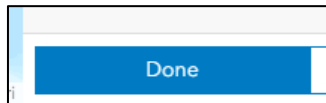

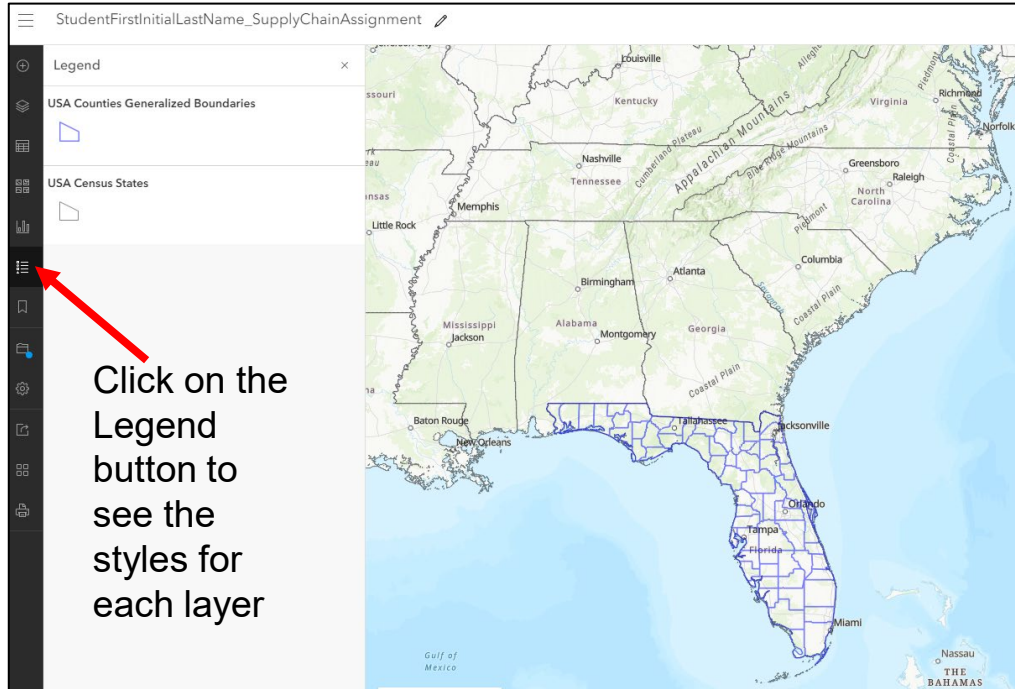

Now do the same thing for the Florida counties, to make them hollow, but choose a different color.



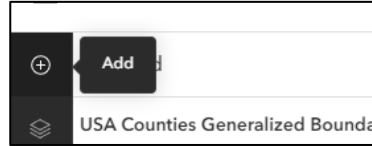

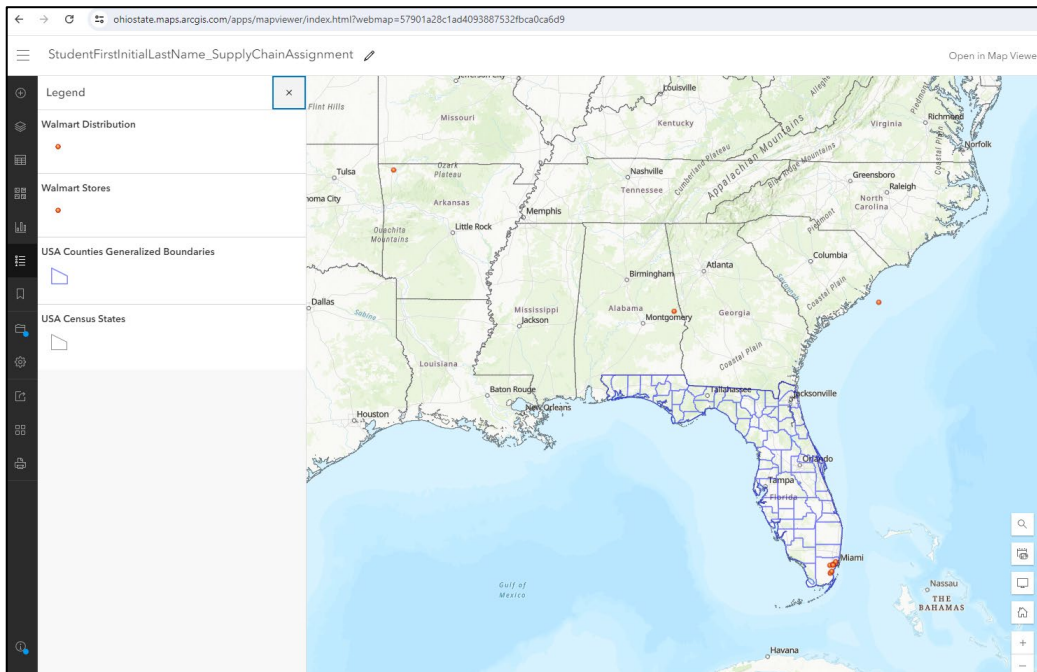


Points are created for each store and the map zooms to the layer.



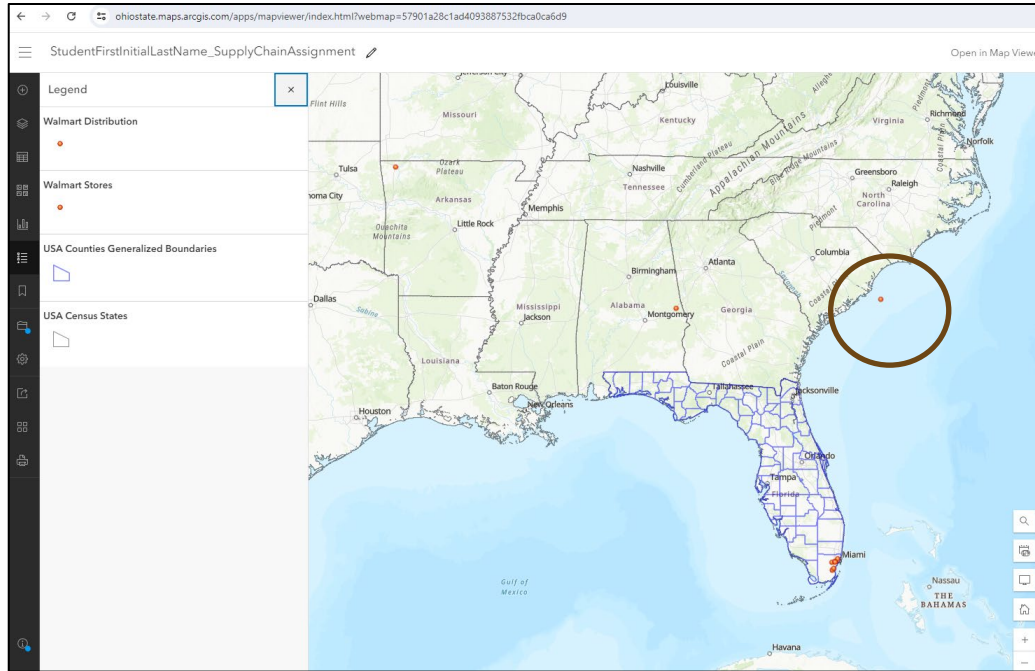

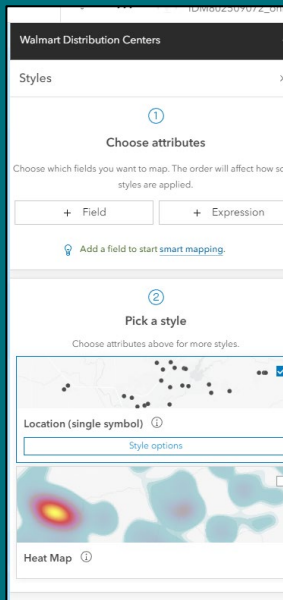
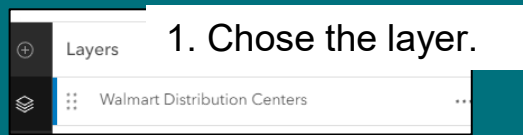
If you have a location that ends up in the wrong place – you will need to double check your latitude and longitude.



Correct it on the Excel, delete the file that was created in GIS, and then redo the process.

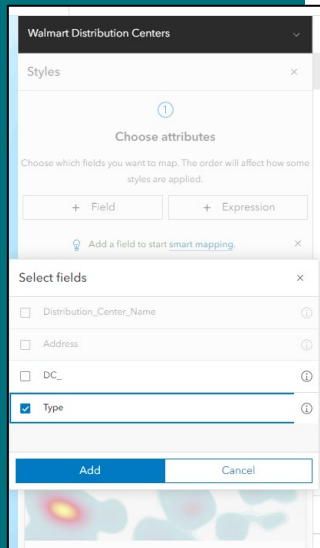
Adding Store and Distribution Center Locations to a Map

Change the styles to distinguish the stores from the distribution centers.

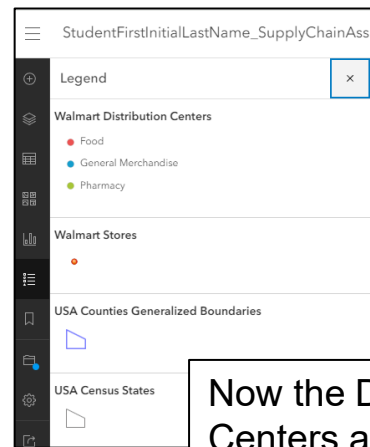


3. Select Type and click Add.

4. Then click Done at the very bottom.



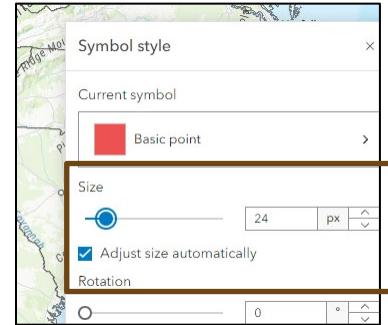
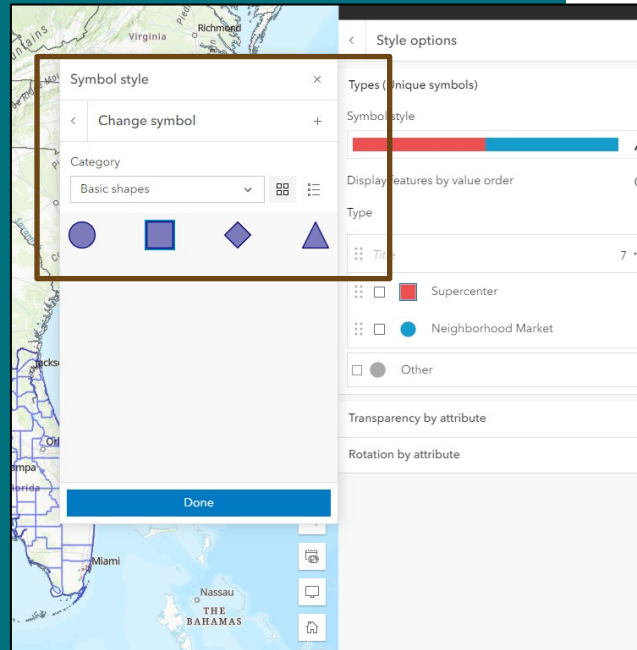
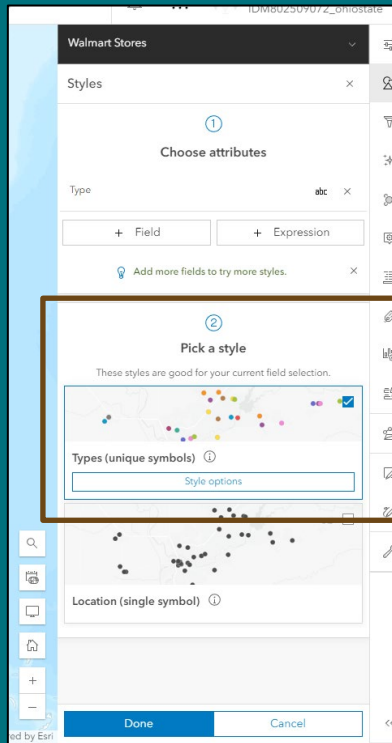

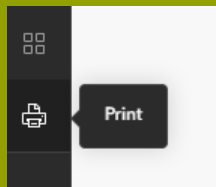
Now the Distribution Centers are identified by Type.

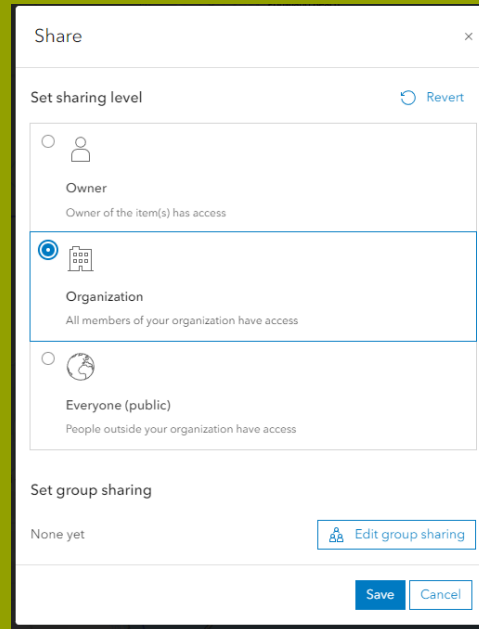

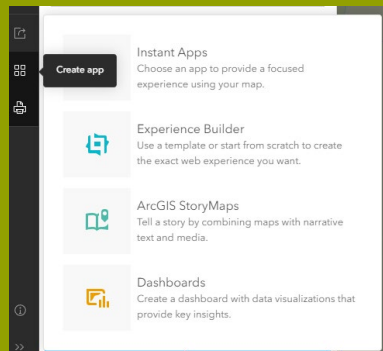
